8 - 15 mmHg

8-15 mmHg Mild Compression

- Tired, achy legs
- Minor foot, ankle and leg swelling
- Helps prevent the formation of varicose and spider veins
- Helps maintain healthy, energized legs



15 - 20 mmHg

15-20 mmHg Moderate Compression

- Minor spider veins
- Minor varicose veins
- Minor foot, ankle and leg swelling
- Helps prevent varicose veins and spider veins
- Helps prevent deep vein thrombosis (DVT)
- Tired, achy legs



20 - 30 mmHg

20-30 mmHg Firm Compression

- Moderate spider veins
- Minor or moderate varicose veins
- Varices during pregnancy
- Minor foot, ankle and leg swelling
- Superficial thrombosis
- Post-sclerotherapy
- Tired, achy legs



30 - 40 mmHg

30-40 mmHg Extra-Firm Compression

- Moderate varicose veins
- Moderate edema
- Lymphatic edema
- Management & prevention of venous ulcers
- Prevention of post-thrombotic syndrome
- Pregnancy with previous phlebitis
- Stasis dermatitis due to Chronic Venous Insufficiency (CVI)
- Orthostatic hypotension



40 - 50 mmHg

40-50 mmHg Extra-Firm Compression

- Severe varicose veins
- Severe edema
- Lymphatic edema
- Management of venous ulcers
- Post-phlebotic syndrome
- Chronic Venous Insufficiency (CVI)
